Politics and Protest: Posters from the Women's Liberation Movement 1970-2000

Politics and Protest is a dynamic, colourful and inspiring exhibition of 70+ posters selected from Feminist Archive South's collection of over 1000. It is freestanding so requires no wall fixings.

- The posters are printed on 2 metre square banners supported by Pegasus system stands.
- Very portable, demounted it will fit easily in an estate car – at a squeeze into a hatchback car (with no passenger). The banners roll up and are transported in 2 meter long card tubes, the stands pack into a purpose made hold-alls.



There are seven different, themed banner designs (see below) They can be displayed with backs to the wall with no fixings



4 banners are single sided, 3 are double sided (3 designs repeated). If space is limited 3 banners can be used double sided and a fourth single sided as pictured here, or in any other suitable constellation – eg at right angles to the wall etc.



OTHER ITEMS TO LOAN

A3 Portfolios of posters augment the banners



Two A3 portfolios hold more posters (that are not in main display)

Folding tables on which portfolios can be displayed are available to loan if needed

Installation at House of Fraser Plymouth. December 2018 Table, portfolios and student work clipped to ribbons.

Pull up roller banner – has information about the exhibition to display in foyer etc



Displaying student work or other paper materials

2 more Pegasus stands can have ribbons attached (supplied). Loops at the top are slotted onto top horizontal pole and fixed with clips at the bottom.

These are useful if you need signs to direct the audience to the specific exhibition space. Type an A4 page with instructions needed and insert.

Booking form

Donations

There is no charge for loan of the exhibition. However, we do ask organisations to pay a voluntary donation to enable us to make the exhibition available to small groups and organisations who may not be able to afford expenses associated with the loan.

Deposits

A refundable deposit will be required to cover the insurance excess for loss or damage. We are currently negotiating with our insurers for the exact amount. The deposit must be paid before final confirmation of the loan can be made. This will be refunded at the end of the loan period subject to the undamaged and complete return of all items loaned.

Installation and Take Down

You will need a small team of people to put up the exhibition. Before the day, please ensure everyone involved has carefully read the instruction leaflet we provide and watched the video (link in the leaflet) . You will need an absolute minimum of 2 and preferably 3-4 people and to allow 2-3 hours if you are using all the banners.

We may be able to provide someone to help you to put up the exhibition.

We do require that a member of our team comes to supervise the take down – that way we can be sure it is ready to go to the next venue – we will need you to pay expenses for this person.

Expenses

Travel and out of pocket expenses for the supervision of the take down of the exhibition must be agreed before the exhibition can be released and paid within 14 days of the exhibition take down. An estimate of the cost can be provided before the event but may be subject to minor changes.

Where supervision of the installation of the exhibition is possible it needs to be by prior agreement and subject to agreement concerning expenses.

If you are unable to cover any of the expenses included in the terms of the loan please talk to us. We do not want organisations to be unable to use the exhibition because they cannot afford it.
